

Multiplier Event - Cologne

The event took place on 9 March in Cologne. It was attended by 23 teachers from vocational schools in the district of Cologne, most of whom work in international support classes in the schools, including some heads of educational programmes. The event began with a digital survey of participants' expectations and experiences of working with refugees. After that, the background of the project application and the objectives of the project were explained by the EU office. The project overview was followed by an insight into the results developed during the project. The results were developed in transnational working groups and were mostly presented by the German project partners of the participating vocational schools.

After the presentation of the curricular teaching modules, the participants had the opportunity to test the teaching material in extracts. This was done for the modules I.-III. and the corresponding teaching materials, among others, via the tool learnigapp. The participants were given access to the individual materials via several QR codes and were able to test them directly on site.

All materials were also presented in paper form at a Market of Possibilities.

Feedback from participants, based on a Forms survey, was overwhelmingly positive. The majority of participants said that they had learnt new content that they would incorporate into their teaching.



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
