This leads to altogether three modules, one focusing on product design and marketing and will be under the leadership of the Portuguese partners. The second one will focus on logistic and IT aspects under the leadership of the Spanish partners and the third one will focus on the interdisciplinary cooperation of a technical and a business and administration VET college during the production. As common product – with different characteristics – all agreed on a drone.</p> <p>The Italian and Czech partners will decide in January which working group/module development group they would like to join.</p> <p>HETEL did a study on already existing interdisciplinary cooperation of VET schools in the Basque country and will make it available for all so that possibly some additional ideas for the further development of the modules will come up.</p> <p>Okresní hospodářská komora Jihlava will do a study especially regarding necessary IT competences of employees in companies.
